



NORTH CAROLINA VETERANS DAY PARADE & Ceremony

On behalf of the Wake County Council of Veterans Organizations (The Council), you are cordially invited to participate in the 31st Annual North Carolina Veterans Day Parade and Ceremony on Friday, November 11th, 2011, in Raleigh, North Carolina.

The parade will begin promptly at 9:30AM and end not later than 10:50AM, in order that the formal observance ceremony, held on the north side of the capitol building by the soldiers' monument, may begin promptly at 11:00AM.

The parade will begin at the intersection of Davies and Fayetteville Streets, proceed north on Fayetteville Street to the state capitol, turn left onto Morgan Street, turn right onto Salisbury Street, right at Edenton Street, and end at the intersection of Edenton and Wilmington Streets.

Parade participants should be in place by 8:30 a.m.

Please check the website frequently for your specific marching order and staging area, since these are subject to change depending on the number of final participants and space requirements.
